He is also a former winner of both the Percussive Arts Society Orchestral Snare Drum Competition and Mock Symphony Audition.

Jeff's is the former percussion director for the DCI World Champion Phantom Regiment Drum and Bugle Corps and currently serves as a championship level adjudicator for both DCI and Percussive Arts Society. He is also a former corps member and has marched in the snare lines of Bayonne Bridgemen, Phantom Regiment and Star of Indiana.

Jeff earned a Bachelor degree in Music Education from Louisiana State University and holds a Master of Music from the University of North Texas. He has pursued and completed all course work toward a Doctoral Degree from the University of North Texas.
